Prof. C. Y. Krishna Murti did his Graduation and Post-graduation in Mathematics at Andhra University and Agra University respectively. He obtained his M.Stat Degree from I.S.I Calcutta. CYK, as he is fondly called joined Indian Statistical Institute as Technical Officer in their SQC & OR Division. Where he was associated with more than 100 organisations, covering Tobacco, Ceramic, Mechanical Engineering, Electrical and Electronics, Heavy Electricals, Polymer and Chemical Processing Industries. His contributions to BHEL, TI and TVS Group of Companies were well recognized and remembered. He has guided more than 500 projects in Quality and Productivity Improvement.

Senior Executives and CEOs of many organisations in and around Chennai were his students. He was a Certified Auditor for ISO-9000 and QS-9000 Quality Management Systems. He was also associated with CII as Quality Expert and was instrumental in industry –academia collaboration in some of the southern centres. The 14 papers published by him have national and international recognition. At the time of his demise, he was the Professor-in-charge of Quality Mission, Project of SQC and OR Division of ISI and Member of Rajiv Gandhi National Award Committee.

CYK upheld the flag of NIQR all the time having played a key role in the merger of NIQA and IAQR and was the first Chairman of Chennai Branch.
