In collaboration with the local prisons authority, TCS has achieved 100% literacy in the district jail in Lucknow, India, by transforming 1,431 inmates functionally literate. Today, ALP has surpassed half a million beneficiaries and the focus has also been on women beneficiaries, who have accounted for more than 80% of total reach so far.

Smart Cities need smart software and city leaders are challenged to address urbanisation and to deliver superior services to citizens across multiple domains –transportation, water, energy, governance and more while managing with limited resources. More and more, they are turning to IoT, BIG Data, and sophisticated analytics to manage, measure, and improve public services. TCS Intelligent Urban Exchange is a modular solution serving many players in the governance of eco system with ready to go applications.

The TCS m Krishilnitiative offers personalised and integrated services in local languages to the farmers on their mobile phones. The service aims to enable farmers in remote areas to connect to their stakeholders, access good quality agricultural inputs, find advice on farming practices and to get information on market prices, weather and other information that can help in planning and boosting the agricultural yields. The vision of TCS is to establish and empower micro enterprises through the m Krishi platform to reach a large number of farmers.
