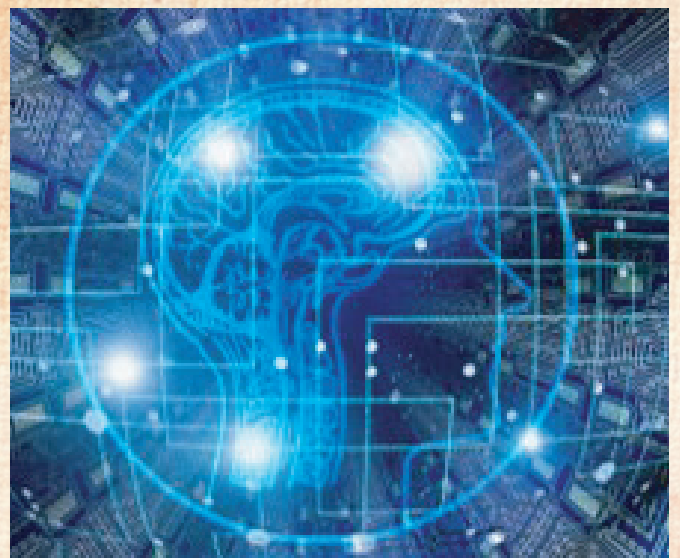
Session 2 - Surmounting the Barriers
