- Results/Benefits

A panel of eminent judges will be evaluating the projects on the basis of DMAIC/Task Achievement approach. Presentation time for each team will be 20 minutes plus 5 minutes for Questions & Answers.

A Maximum of only 3 members will be allowed per team. Only registered teams and participants are eligible to participate. However, as a contingency plan, change in nomination of any one member may be allowed by the NIQR Management with prior permission by 5.00 pm on 15th December 2024.

A team consisting of more than 3 persons will have to pay additional fees of Rs.4,200/- + 18% GST (Rs.4,956/-)per participant for every additional team member.
